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No Parasites Statement

SALMONES CAMANCHACA S.A. - CHILE states that all their fresh seafood products have been produced under the Hazard Analysis and Critical Control Points (HACCP) System, in accordance with the FDA Seafood HACCP Regulations, 21 CFR part 123, and the FDA Current Good Manufacturing Practices, 21 CFR Part 110.

SALMONES CAMANCHACA S.A. states that their farmed Atlantic Salmon (*Salmo salar*) is raised only on pelleted feed in an aquaculture operation. Species that normally have a parasite hazard as a result of consuming infected prey apparently do not have the same parasite hazard when raised only pelleted feed, by this reason is not necessary to consider such aquaculture fish as having a parasite hazard, this is in accordance with the Chapter 5 of The FDA Fish and Fisheries Fourth Edition, April 2011 pag 92.
